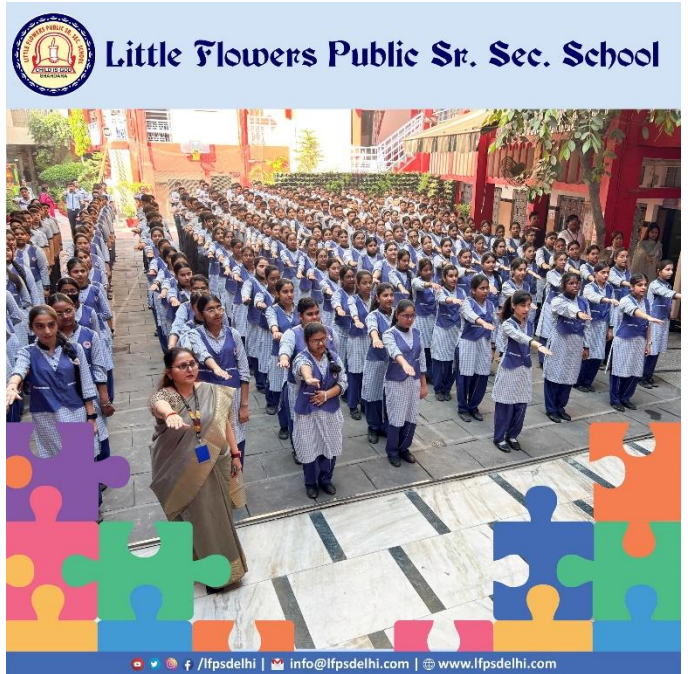


# REPORT- WORLD AUTISM AWARENESS DAY
